RESOLUTION NO. 1950 Series of 2025

EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FOR THE FILING OF APPLICATION FOR THE APRIL 2025 CIVIL ENGINEERS LICENSURE EXAMINATION FROM FEBRUARY 11, 2025 TO MARCH 11, 2025

WHEREAS, Section 7 (d) of Republic Act No. 8981, or the "PRC Modernization Act of 2000", empowers the Professional Regulation Commission (Commission) to administer and conduct the licensure examinations of the various regulatory boards in accordance with the rules and regulations it may promulgate, and to determine and fix the places and dates of examinations;

WHEREAS, the Commission issued Resolution No. 1927 (s. 2024) scheduling the licensure examinations for calendar year 2025, including the opening of online processing, deadlines for filing of applications, practical examinations, and target dates of release of examination results;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the abovementioned Resolution, the Civil Engineers Licensure Examination (CELE) is scheduled on April 28 -29, 2025 and the deadline for the filing of application is on February 11, 2025;

WHEREAS, some of the prospective examinees requested to extend the deadline for the filing of the applications for the said licensure examination to give them enough time to complete all documentary requirements;

WHEREAS, the Professional Regulatory Board of Civil Engineering and the Licensure Office recommend to the Commission the approval of the request;

WHEREFORE, premises considered, the Commission RESOLVES, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to EXTEND the deadline for the filing of applications of the April 2025 Civil Engineers Licensure Examination from February 11, 2025 to March 11, 2025.

RESOLVED FURTHER, all required documents for the filing of application to take the licensure examination must be submitted to the Commission on or before March 11, 2025.
