Licensure Examination for Professional Teachers in Koronadal City (March 23, 2025)



The Professional Regulation Commission - Regional Office XII hereby informs the examinees of the March 2025 Professional Teachers' Licensure Examination in KORONADAL CITY of the following guidelines:

Venues of the Examination:

- Koronadal Central Elementary School I – Jose Rizal Street, Brgy. Zone IV, City of Koronadal
- King's College of Marbel, Inc. – Gen. Santos Drive, Brgy. Morales, City of Koronadal
- Sto. Niño Elementary School - Barrio 2-Barrio 5 Rd, Brgy. Sto. Niño, City of Koronadal
- Ramon Magsaysay Memorial Colleges, Marbel Inc. - Arellano St., Prk. Waling-Waling, Brgy. Zone II, City of Koronadal
- Marbel 1 Central Elementary School – Cudilla St., Brgy. General Paulino Santos, City of Koronadal
- Osita Central Elementary School – Osita Subdivision, Brgy. Zone II, City of Koronadal

Required items/ documents during the examination day

1. Official Receipt of payment of application for examination
 2. Notice of Admission
 3. One (1) piece Long Transparent White Plastic Envelope (for keeping valuables and other allowed items)
 4. One (1) piece long size brown envelope
 5. Two (2) or more Pencils (No. 2)
 6. Ball pen with black ink only
 7. Basic Calculator for Secondary Level- Mathematics Major only
- Calculator with the following features only: addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, trigonometric function, logarithm, and exponential function xy (Per Commission Resolution No. 1809-2024)

NOTE: ONLY ONE CALCULATOR PER EXAMINEE SHALL BE ALLOWED INSIDE THE EXAMINATION ROOM. ALL CALCULATORS SHALL BE INSPECTED AND HAVE TO BE RESET BEFORE THE EXAMINATION STARTS.

Prohibited items inside the examination premises/ rooms

1. Books, notes, review materials, and all other printed materials containing coded data/ information/ formulas.
2. All kinds of calculators EXCEPT for Secondary Level MATHEMATICS MAJOR pursuant to Commission Resolution No. 1809-2024
3. Mobile phones, smart watches such as Apple, Samsung, or other brands, earplugs, transmitters, portable computers, Bluetooth, and other electronic gadgets/devices that may be used to store or retrieve data/ information or to communicate for whatever purposes.
4. Bags of any kind (ladies' bag, shoulder bags, attaché case, backpacks, etc.)
5. Other examination aides not stated in the board program.

What to wear on the examination day

Examinees are required to wear the following attire on the examination day:

Male Examinees - Tucked-in white polo shirt with collar (without any seal, logo, or mark), decent pants or slacks

Female Examinees - Tucked-in white blouse or shirt with collar (without any seal, logo, or mark), decent pants or slacks

Examinees must be well-groomed, with hair properly clipped and/or pony-tailed.

General instructions to the examinees

1. Check or verify your school assignment at the PRC official website (www.prc.gov.ph) two (2) to three (3) working days before the examination.
2. On the examination day, report to the school/building assignment before 5:30 A.M. Be punctual. Late examinees will not be admitted.
3. The rules on the conduct of bodily search, inspection of personal belongings of the examinees, and the seizure/confiscation of prohibited items during the licensure exam (Annex A of PRC Memorandum Order No. 57, s. 2020) shall be strictly observed.
4. Loitering and unnecessary conversing in the hallways or the examination rooms are STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
5. Examinees shall bring their prepacked meals/ snacks and water/drink upon entry to the examination room, which shall be eaten on their assigned seats. Food deliveries are NOT allowed during the examination.
6. Use of polyethylene terephthalate (PET) bottles, plastic wrappers, and food packages shall be avoided in observance of the city's solid waste management initiatives. Litters must be disposed of properly in the designated garbage bins.
7. Read and follow the instructions on your NOTICE OF ADMISSION and EXAMINEES GUIDE.
8. Personal belongings brought by an examinee shall be for his/her account. The PRC will not be answerable for any such item or personal belonging that might be lost during the exam without fault or negligence on its part.
9. Cheating and all other prohibited acts as stipulated in Memorandum Order No. 57, series of 2020, which will impair the integrity and credibility of the licensure examination shall be dealt with accordingly.
