The Professional Regulation Commission - Regional Office XII hereby informs all the concerned examinees of the aforesaid licensure examination in **KORONADAL CITY** of the following important guidelines:

Venues of the Examination:

- Koronadal Central Elementary School 1 Barangay Zone IV, Koronadal City
- ❖ Bacongco National High School Brgy. San Isidro, Koronadal City

Bring the following on the examination day:

- 1. Official Receipt
- 2. Notice of Admission
- 3. Ball pen with **BLACK** ink only
- 4. Two (2) or more Pencils (No. 2)
- 5. One (1) piece long size brown envelope
- 6. One (1) piece Long Transparent Plastic Envelope (for keeping valuables and other allowed items)
- 7. For LEPT Secondary Level Mathematics Major Only Calculators with the following features only: addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, trigonometric function, logarithm, and x^y.
 - Note: ONLY ONE BASIC CALCULATOR SHALL BE ALLOWED INSIDE THE EXAMINATION ROOM. ALL CALCULATORS SHALL BE INSPECTED AND HAVE TO BE RESET BEFORE THE START OF THE EXAMINATION.

PROHIBITED items inside the examination premises/rooms

- 1. Books, notes, review materials, and all other printed materials containing coded data/ information/ formulas
- 2. **For LEPT Elementary Level** ALL KINDS OF CALCULATOR
 - <u>For LEPT Secondary Level</u>-ALL KINDS OF CALCULATOR EXCEPT FOR THOSE WITH MATHEMATICS MAJOR PURSUANT TO BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 25 SERIES 2019
- 3. Mobile phones, smart watches such as Apple, Samsung, or other brands, earplugs, transmitters, portable computers, Bluetooth, and other electronic gadgets/devices that may be used to store or retrieve data/information and/ or to communicate for whatever purposes.
- 4. Bags of any kind (ladies' bag, shoulder bags, attaché case, backpacks, etc.)
- 5. Other examination aids not stated in the board program.

General Instructions to the Examinees

- 1. Check or verify your school assignment at the PRC official website (www.prc.gov.ph) two (2) to three (3) working days before the examination. Bring your NOTICE OF ADMISSION when you verify your school assignment. Visit your school assignment before the day of the examination.
- 2. On the day of the examination, report to your school assignment no later than 5:30 A.M. Be punctual. Late examinees will not be admitted.
- 3. Examinees are required to wear the following attire on examination day:
 - **Male Examinees** Tucked-in white polo shirt with collar (without any seal, logo, or mark), decent pants or slacks
 - **Female Examinees** Tucked-in white blouse or shirt with collar (without any seal, logo, or mark), decent pants or slacks
- 4. Examinees must be well-groomed, with hair properly clipped and/or pony-tailed.

- 5. All personal belongings shall be surrendered to the proctor and shall be placed in a secured space within the examination room.
 - NOTE: PERSONAL BELONGINGS BROUGHT BY AN EXAMINEE SHALL BE FOR HIS/HER ACCOUNT. THE PRC WILL NOT BE ANSWERABLE FOR ANY SUCH ITEM OR PERSONAL BELONGING THAT MIGHT BE LOST DURING THE EXAM WITHOUT FAULT OR NEGLIGENCE ON ITS PART.
- 6. Loitering and unnecessary conversing in the hallways or the examination rooms are STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
- 7. Examinees shall bring their prepacked meals/ snacks and water/drink upon entry to the examination room, which shall be eaten on their assigned seats. Food deliveries are NOT allowed during the examination.
- 8. Use of polyethylene terephthalate (PET) bottles, plastic wrappers, and food packages shall be avoided in observance of the solid waste management initiatives of the city and the partner schools. Litters must be disposed of properly in the designated garbage bins.
- Cheating and all other forms of prohibited acts as stipulated in Memorandum Order No. 57, series of 2020, which will impair the integrity and credibility of the licensure examination shall be dealt with accordingly.
