**APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION WITHOUT EXAMINATION
AS MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNICIAN**

WHEREAS, Section 21(3)¹ of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 5527, also known as the “Philippine Medical Technology Act of 1969”, as amended, states that the Professional Regulatory Board of Medical Technology (Board) shall issue a certificate of registration without examination as medical laboratory technician, subject to compliance with the conditions therein prescribed;
