**CHEMICAL ENGINEER LICENSURE EXAMINATION
RESULTS RELEASED IN ONE (1) DAY**

The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **151** out of **329** passed the Chemical Engineer Licensure Examination given by the **Board of Chemical Engineering** in **Manila** this **April 2010**.

The members of the Board of Chemical Engineering are **Engr. Ofelia V. Bulaong**, Chairman; **Engr. Francisco A. Arellano** and **Engr. Jeffrey G. Mijares**, Members.

Registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will start on Wednesday, April 28, 2010 but not later than May 7, 2010. Those who will register are required to bring the following: duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, current Community Tax Certificate (cedula), 3 pieces passport size picture (colored with white background and complete nametag), 1 piece 1" x 1" picture (colored with white background and complete nametag), 2 sets of metered documentary stamps, and 1 short brown envelope with name and profession; and to pay the Initial Registration Fee of ₱600 and Annual Registration Fee of ₱450 for 2010-2013. **Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.**

The oath-taking ceremony of the successful examinees in the said examination as well as the previous ones who have not taken their Oath of Professional will be held before the Board on Saturday, May 29, 2010 at 11:00 o'clock in the morning at the Sofitel Hotel, Philippine Plaza Manila, CCP Complex Roxas Boulevard, Pasay City. Registration for the oath-taking ceremony and for membership with the **Philippine Institute of Chemical Engineers (PICHE)** will take place after registration as a professional with the Board and the Commission.
