OPTOMETRIST

"Optometry" - The science and art of examining the human eye, analyzing the ocular function, prescribing and dispensing ophthalmic lenses, prisms, contact lenses and their accessories and solutions, low vision aids, and similar appliances and devices, conducting ocular exercises, vision training, orthoptics, installing prosthetics, using authorized diagnostic pharmaceutical agents (DPA), and other preventive or corrective measures or procedures for the aid, correction, rehabilitation or relief of the human eye, or to attain maximum vision and comfort.

THE FUNCTION

- (a) Comprehensive Eye and Vision Examination;
- (b) Detect ocular diseases and visual anomalies with the use of specific topical diagnostic pharmaceutical agents or drugs;
- (c) Dispense ophthalmic prescription lenses, contact lenses, low vision aids and safety goggles to correct error of refraction for the eyes to see clearly at far and near;



- d) Conduct ocular exercises, vision therapy and rehabilitation procedures to correct abnormalities of the human vision;
- (e) Provide cosmetic contact lenses for corneal opacities and ocular prosthesis after eye removal surgery;
- (f) Counseling of patients with regard to vision and eye care and hygiene;

There is a very great demand for optometry services locally and internationally. In the Philippines, the incidence of visual disorders is increasing among the younger generation because of the increasing near activity tasks brought about by the high technology electronic devices commonly used.
